**Resolution of the Alabama Republican Executive Committee to Urge the  
Monitoring and Restriction of the Marketing of Body Parts of Aborted Babies**

**WHEREAS**, the people of Alabama, as moral people, have always defended the sanctity of human life as God-given, and strongly oppose the abortion of unborn children, and have a long-standing commitment to ending abortions and have enacted Alabama laws with penalties for aiding and abetting abortion; and

**WHEREAS**, numerous studies document the overwhelming tragedy of abortion which includes not only the killing of unborn human beings, but also includes the destructive effects upon the mother and other family members; and

**WHEREAS**, the vast majority of women who have abortion live lives of regret even though there is God-given grace and forgiveness available to them; and

**WHEREAS**, the tragedy of abortion is compounded by the evil and disgusting practice of selling body parts of aborted babies; and

**WHEREAS**, no law presently exists in the Alabama State Code prohibiting or restricting the sale of aborted baby parts, and no regulatory provision exists that requires the monitoring of such by the Alabama Department of Health; and

**WHEREAS**, the President of the United States and his party have fostered a hostile environment toward the sanctity of life, and seek to force people to subsidize abortions under Obama-Care, and provide no restrictions on the sale of body parts of aborted babies; and

**WHEREAS**, Planned Parenthood has irrevocably been found by the Center for Medical Progress to be actively engaged and leading in illegal abortion practices such as profit-based altering of abortion procedures, partial-birth abortions, and terminating the lives of babies born from failed abortions; and

**WHEREAS**, five abortion clinics in Alabama (located in Huntsville, Birmingham, Tuscaloosa, Montgomery and Mobile) operate with impunity, destroying over 8,000 unborn human beings each year, shipping them to pathology labs with no oversight by the Alabama Department of Health; and

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED**, that the Alabama Republican Executive Committee urges the members of Congress and the leaders of all three branches of State government, and the Alabama Department of Health to adopt and enforce statutory laws and regulatory means to monitor and to prohibit, or restrict to the maximum extent possible, the hideous practice of marketing the body parts of aborted babies.

**MOREOVER**, the Alabama Republican Executive Committee publicly condemns Planned Parenthood and calls for all levels of government to completely defund Planned Parenthood.
